



Lifeguard Games Code of Conduct

This code of conduct is to set the standard for behavior and sportsmanship at the Utah Aquatic Lifeguard Games. The rules set forth here are to be followed and upheld throughout the games and by all participants, judges and volunteers. Not adhering to this code will result in disqualification and a ban from future events.

- 1- Have FUN
- 2- Show the utmost discipline and sportsmanship at all times
- 3- Win or lose with the same integrity
- 4- Arrive to the event and stations on time
- 5- No profanity
- 6- Respect your teammates, judges, volunteers and other lifeguard teams; issues with other players or judges should be brought to the attention of a Utah Aquatic Representative immediately
- 7- Cheer for other participants and teams; no taunting, disrespectful or rude language towards others will be tolerated
- 8- Follow all facility rules at all times
- 9- Photography is allowed and encouraged throughout the event, however, personal videos will not be allowed during events, judges' comments or scoring. If a team shares video of events with another team during the games both teams will be disqualified.

The focus of the Utah Aquatic Lifeguard Game's is to promote aquatic safety and lifeguard excellence. Anyone not following this Code of Conduct or who is not promoting that mission will be asked to leave the event.
